NEW BUSINESS

- **Bryan Clements**, executive director of security and technology, presented the Technology Protection Measure and Internet Safety Policy. The presentation included information on the district's Acceptable Use Policy, Internet Filtering System and Internet Safety Curriculum.
- North Shore Senior High student **Ryan Perez** has been named a semifinalist in the 56th annual National Merit Scholarship Program. Ryan was recognized for his exceptional academic promise along with approximately 16,000 semifinalists throughout the nation. Semifinalists represent less than one percent of more than 1.5 million students who entered the 2011 competition by taking the 2009 Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test.
- North Shore Senior High School students **Emmanuel Herrera** and **John Mendiola**, North Shore Senior High, have been named Commended Students in the 2011 National Merit Scholarship Program. They were recognized for their exceptional academic promise along with approximately 34,000 commended students throughout the nation. Commended students placed among the top five percent of more than 1.5 million students who entered the 2011 competition by taking the 2009 Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test.
