## NEW BUSINESS

### GENERAL CONSENT AGENDA

- **Approved** the submission of the application for the Timeline for Accelerated Instruction Waiver as presented. The District requests permission to apply for an expedited waiver to adjust the timeline for providing the accelerated instruction required for placement in/promotion to the next grade. The waiver is limited to students who fail the third administration of the grade 5 or 8 TAKS reading and/or math test. As a result, students will receive the accelerated instruction required by law during the first six weeks of school as opposed to receiving the instruction in August (prior to the beginning of school).
- **Approved** the Early Head Start Corrective Action Plan in preparation for the follow up Office of Head Start visit scheduled for September 13-14, 2010, as presented.

- Accepted the renewal proposal from Texas Political Subdivisions Joint Self-Insurance Fund to provide Workers' Compensation Guaranteed Cost Coverage for the coverage year of October 1, 2010 through September 30, 2011 at the net cost of \$850,756 as presented.
