A. Previewing Odyssey Curriculum

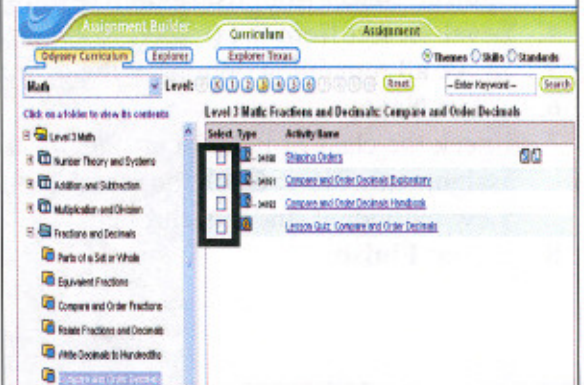
1. Select the desired grade level

B. Assigning Lessons

Selecting a Lesson

1. Select Odyssey Curriculum / Subject / Grade / Search method (Themes, Skills or Standards)
2. You can select a Unit, Lesson or Activity. Drill down to the level needed.
3. Check the box next to the curriculum you want to assign.. If you select a Unit or Lesson folder, all sub activities will be included.
4. Select: Add Selected Task



Sequential Order

Note: If your assignment is 100% Self-Select and NOT

Sequential, Select: Complete Assignment.

To set Assignments with Sequential Order:

1. Check the box next to the title
2. Above the dialog box, select **Sequential** or **Self-Select**.

Note: You may want folders to be Self-Select.

3. Drill down on each level, check and select **Sequential** for the items you want to appear in sequential order.
4. **Sequential Numbering**: You can change the order in which activities appear, when you have typed in a new order, click: **Update**
5. Select: **Complete Assignment / OK**

Completing the Assignment

1. Type in the Assignment Name and optional Description
2. Availability: Select from list
3. Subject: Select from list (required)
4. Level: Select from list (required)
5. Leave all remaining options at the default
6. Select **Next**
7. Check the class or individual students that will receive the assignment. Note: Click the + sign to expand the class to view individual students enrolled.
8. Select: **Finish**
