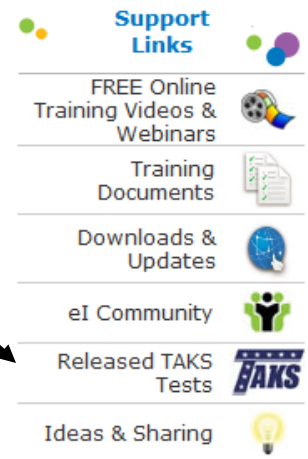


1. Open the Internet to [www.iclick2engage.com](http://www.iclick2engage.com).



2. Click on **product support**.

3. Select **Released TAKS Tests** from the menu on the right side of the screen.



4. **PLEASE NOTE:**

- a. 2003, 2004, 2005 and 2006 are CPS lesson files. The questions are editable within CPS.
- b. The 2005 test is Exit Level only.
- c. Reading passages for any TAKS questions must be obtained from the TEA website.

5. Choose the year, subject area and format (Windows or Mac) of the tests you would like to download.

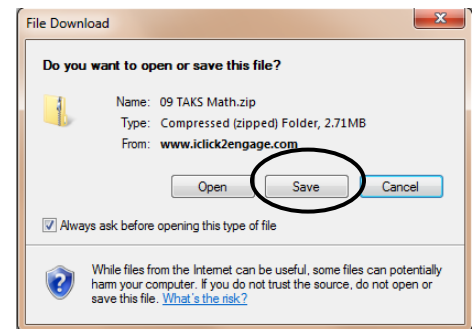

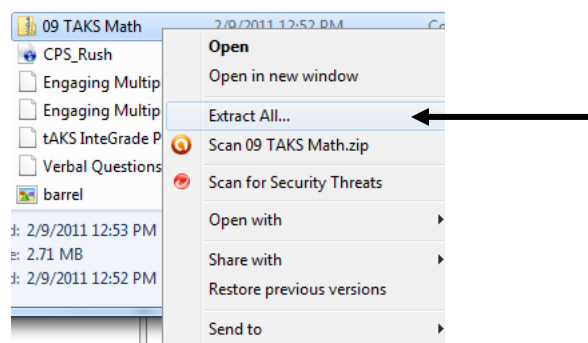

6. When asked if you want to save or open the file, choose **Save**. Browse to your CPS folder and save the zipped file there.

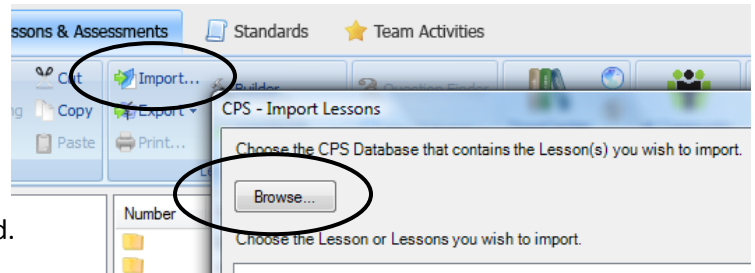




7. You will need to unzip, or extract, the zipped folder of tests. Find the zipped folder in your CPS folder. Depending on the contents of your CPS folder, you may have to look around a bit to find the zipped TAKS folder. Right click and choose **Extract All...**

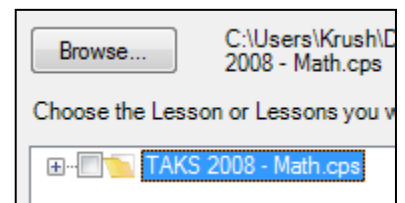


8. Within the CPS program, create a folder named **Released TAKS Tests**. To do this, highlight your database, click on the New plus sign and choose **Folder** from the dropdown.
9. To import a **CPS .cxm** file:

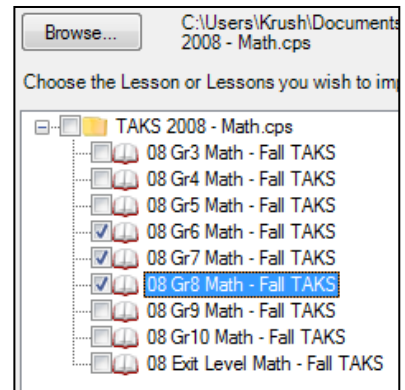
- a. Click to select your Released TAKS Tests folder and click **Import** from the Lessons & Assessments tab.
- b. Click **Browse** to find the files you just unzipped.



- c. All grade levels of that TAKS tests are in one database, so you will find one file with the CPS symbol  
- d. When you double click on that file you will then see a folder in the Browse window.



- e. You **MUST** click the plus sign (+) next to the folder in order to choose specific tests. Checkmark the box next to each test you would like and click OK at the bottom.



- f. The file will import and you will see a confirmation window. The test/s will now be available in your Released TAKS Tests folder.
