Goal 1: Climate

Goal 2: High Expectations

Tice Elementary will identify areas of improvement to better prepare students for college and careers.

- Objective 2.1:** Students will participate in career day.
- Objective 2.2:** Banners designating class graduating year will be posted for grades K-5 to promote "Destination Graduation."
- Objective 2.3:** Students will visit a sixth grade campus.

Goal 3: Instruction

Tice Elementary will define measures by which student success can be determined, relative to the tested, foundation curriculum areas of mathematics, social studies, science, and English/ Language Arts and the enrichment curriculum areas not tested by TAKS including music, theater, art,technology,and dance.

- Objective 3.1:** 90% of all student groups (including Special Education, 504, At-Risk, and Dyslexia) will achieve mastery on appropriate assessments through the utilization of effective instructional/programs designed to meet their academic and social needs.
- Objective 3.2:** Ensure correct placement and programming for all students(including LEP, Bilingual, Special Education, Early Childhood, Gifted & talented, Etc.) based on current AEIS data.
- Objective 3.3:** Provide a variety of programs/extracurricular areas designed to encourage student participation in school activities such as after-school athletics, drama, technology, choir and dance..
- Objective 3.4:** Apply a variety of proven practices to ensure that all students achieve success.
- Objective 3.5:** Improve student achievement and decrease retentions through the use of several intensive accelerated instructional programs such as OEY, AMI, ARI, Accelerated Reader, technology, Odyssey
- Objective 3.6:** Use district assessment and RTI data to monitor student progress.
- Objective 3.7:** Provide instruction by highly qualified teachers.
- Objective 3.8:** provide high- quality, on-going staff development to maintain (retain) 100% of classes taught by highly qualified teachers in the core academic subject areas to enable all children to meet the state's academic achievement standards.
- Objective 3.9:** Attract high-quality qualified teachers.

Goal 4: Student Attendance

Tice Elementary will aggressively seek to have 96% or higher student attendance.

- Objective 4.1:** Provide incentives for perfect attendance each nine weeks (Park, Pizza, Movie, Dance, Lunch Crew).
