# CCTV - Surveillance

- ◆ All Facilities have CCTV
- ◆ Approximately 1,000 cameras
  - GPHS 89
  - NSSH 126
- ◆ Moving to I.P. based technology
  - More storage
  - Better images
  - More expensive

# What are the odds?

- ◆ The probability that any school age child will die this year from:
  - Any cause 1 in 3,000
  - A traffic accident 1 in 8,000
  - Homicide, away from school 1 in 21,000
  - A firearm accident 1 in 200,000
  - Pneumonia or influenza 1 in 250,000
  - Accidental fall 1 in 390,000
  - An act of nature, including lightning 1 in 780,000
  - Homicide at school 1 in 3,000,000
