Summer School Registration Set

Academic courses will be located at **North Shore Senior High School 9th/10th**.

Sessions:

1st Semester June 4 - June 16
2nd Semester June 18 - June 30
Monday – Friday

Times:

Six and one half (6 1/2) hours per day from 8:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Credits:

Each semester course will earn 1/2 credit.

Registration:

In order to register, **an approved registration card must be obtained from your counselor.** Additionally, your tuition must be paid on one of the designated days. Out-of-district students must bring a

permission form from their home school.

Regular Registration will be **May 30** from 3:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. at **Galena Park High School, North Shore High School and North Shore Senior High School**; and **June 2 and 3** from 8:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. at **North Shore Senior High School 9th/10th** only.



Late Registration will be held on **June 4** from 8:00 am until 3:00 pm at **NSSHS 9th/10th** only. Second semester registration may be done at the summer school office at **NSSHS 9th/10th** during the regular hours of the first semester and also on **June 17** from 8:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.

Another person may submit the registration card and pay the tuition for you **provided**

that a counselor has approved your registration card at your school.

There will be a late registration fee of \$25.00 for the first semester after June 3. Second semester must be paid by 3:00 p.m. on June 17 to avoid \$25.00 late fee.

PLEASE DO NOT WAIT UNTIL THE LAST DAY, THE LINES GET VERY LONG. For more information, please see your counselor.

Tuition: CASH ONLY, NO CHECKS

Tuition is \$150.00 per course (9 days) for in-district students and \$250.00 per course for out-of-district students.

Attendance: If a student is absent more than one day per semester, no credit will be given for the course unless the time is made up. A student should be absent only if seriously ill or has a death in the family. When a student

misses one-half (1/2) of the class, he will be considered absent for the day. If this makes the second absence, then no credit will be given for the course unless the time is made up. Three (3) tardies equals an absence.

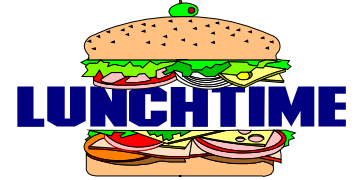
Discipline: Students should conduct themselves in a proper manner at all times, both inside and outside the classroom. Any student may be dropped from school without refund for improper conduct. Fighting anywhere on the campus may result in suspension from school. Smoking, using other tobacco products or using or possessing illegal drugs or alcohol will result in suspension from school. Public display of affection is definitely not permitted. The rules of common courtesy should be practiced at all times. The Galena Park ISD Discipline Plan will be followed.

Dress: The Galena Park Independent School District Dress Code will be in effect. Improper dress or hair will not be permitted and may result in suspension. If clothing or hair is borderline, don't wear it.

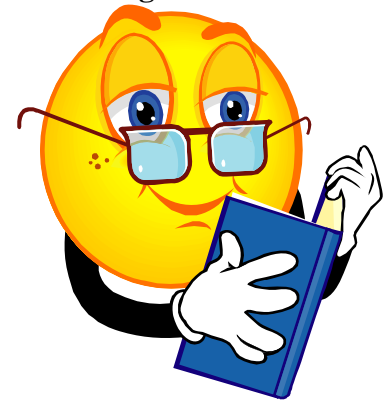
Visitors: Visitors are not permitted in summer school. Tell your friends not to contact you at school and not to come

on the campus during school hours.

Office: The summer school office will be in the office area of **North Shore Senior High School 9th/10th** and the phone number is 832-386-3413.



Free breakfast and lunch will be provided at **North Shore Senior High School 9th/10th**.



Bus Service: Students living in the, **Galena Park, Jacinto City, Fidelity, Galena Manor, and Woodland Acres** areas of the district will be provided bus service if sufficient numbers of students ride the bus. Bus will leave Galena Park High School bus ramp at **7:00 a.m.** Stops will be made at Munn and Holland in Jacinto City. Pyburn Elementary, and Woodland Acres Middle school bus ramps. The Fidelity, Galena Manor area will also be

accommodated. **Improper conduct will result in not being allowed to ride the bus!**

Opening Day: On June 4 at 8:00 a.m. students will report to their assigned rooms. There will be notices in the halls where each class is located. Bring normal school supplies the first day.
