Theatre Action Project (TAP) is a nonprofit educational theatre company impacting the lives of thousands of PreK-12th grade students and the adults who care for them in Central Texas. Our programming creates a safe, fun, and dynamic way for students to realize their potential, discover their strengths, and find their voices. Our professional Teaching Artists guide children through interactive, dramatic presentations and help students become active learners as they examine situations, act out solutions, and take positive risks through performance and creative expression.



We have four core programs:

- **Five-Day Interactive Performance Residencies:** 4 different touring shows for the classroom that use role play, puppetry, song, group activities and dramatic presentations to teach young people about issues including: bullying, conflict resolution, racism and healthy communication.
- **TAP After School:** Over 280 hours of theatre arts enrichment classes each week at 35 area campuses
- **TAP in the Community:** Customized special programs, community events, festivals, parades and parenting workshops
- **Youth for Youth Theatre Companies:** Middle School and High School populations educate their peers on important social issues through theatre. Offered in partnership with a variety of community organizations.
