UPDATES FOR ELEMENTARY AND MIDDLE SCHOOL

Ripped/Torn pants are acceptable.
Any exposed skin above the knee
must have leggings underneath.
Exposed skin below the knee is acceptable.

No yoga pants, spandex, or tights

No flannel pants

No hoods on heads

No beanies/caps unless designated by administrators

No midriff/crop tops

No blankets or pillows

VISITOR CLEAR BAG REGULATION
