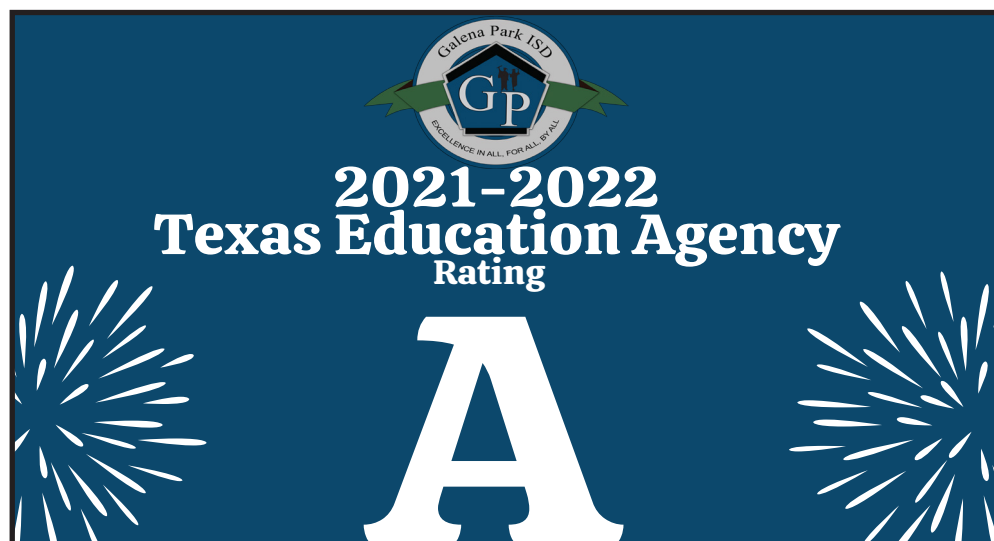
- 12 ELA/Reading Distinctions
