Galena Park ISD Host Ribbon Cutting Ceremony for Legacy Community Health Clinic

Houston, Texas: On Monday, September 20, 2021, Galena Park ISD (GPISD) hosted the Legacy Community Clinic Ribbon Cutting Ceremony and Open House at Galena Park Middle School.

The ribbon cutting ceremony was conducted by the North Channel Area Chamber of Commerce. Dr. John Moore, Galena Park ISD Superintendent of Schools, was joined by Dr. Angi Williams, retired GPISD Superintendent of Schools, the Galena Park ISD Board of Trustees, City of Galena Park Mayor, Esmeralda Moya, Legacy Community Health personnel and Mr. Lee Ramirez, principal of Galena Park Middle School.
