Galena Park I.S.D. Selected for the TASA/TASB Star of Distinction to School Architecture Projects Award

Houston, Texas: The Texas Association of School Administrators (TASA) and Texas Association of School Boards (TASB) selected two Galena Park I.S.D. campuses for the TASA/TASB Stars of Distinction to School Architecture Projects award.

Cloverleaf Elementary School and Galena Park Elementary School have been selected to be honored at the 2020 TASA/TASB Convention's Exhibit of School Architecture, which celebrates excellence in planning and design of the learning environment. Cloverleaf Elementary was designed by IBI Group, Inc. and Galena Park Elementary was designed by PBK Architects.

Forty-eight projects will be included in the 2020-2021 Exhibit of School Architecture, this online exhibit of newly, renovated Texas school facilities includes 34 school districts, three colleges, and one regional education service center that were submitted by 18 architecture firms. The Exhibit of School Architecture awards are given at the discretion of a 12-member jury, which includes: four school board members, four school administrators, and four members from the Association for Learning Environments Southern Region.
