

GALENA PARK I.S.D. COVID-19 Response Levels

SEVERE RESPONSE LEVEL

All education will be conducted via remote learning - 100% online

Maintain close coordination with local health officials

Eligible staff will work from home

SIGNIFICANT RESPONSE LEVEL

All education will be conducted via remote learning - Targeted students may be on campus

Mandatory face coverings for 1st through 12th grade students and all staff

Teach and reinforce health hygiene

Intensify cleaning and disinfection of commonly touched surfaces and areas

Postpone/cancel all noncritical gatherings and events

Implement multiple social distancing strategies for gatherings, classrooms, and movement through the building

No outside visitors

Eligible staff will work from home 50% of the time (Eligible staff will work on a rotating basis)

MODERATE RESPONSE LEVEL

Hybrid and remote learning option

Mandatory face coverings for 1st through 12th grade students and all staff

Teach and reinforce health hygiene

Intensify cleaning and disinfection of commonly touched surfaces and areas

Postpone/cancel all noncritical gatherings and events

Implement multiple social distancing strategies for gatherings, classrooms, and movement through the building

Restrict outside visitors to essential services only

Limit number of students on campuses

Alter capacity limits on school buses

Employees report to work

MINIMAL RESPONSE LEVEL

Face to face 5 days per week and remote learning option

Mandatory face coverings for 1st through 12th grade students and all staff

Teach and reinforce health hygiene

Maintain frequent cleaning and disinfection of commonly touched surfaces and areas

Implement multiple social distancing strategies for gatherings, classrooms, and movement through the building

Restrict outside visitors and guests

Monitor attendance and communicate with local health authorities

Alter capacity limits on school buses

Employees report to work
