General Announcements:

NSSH along with GPISD will be hosting 100% remote learning for the first 4 weeks of school. The Learning Management System (LMS) all Mustangs will use is Google Classroom. All Mustangs are expected to engage in four live sessions a day. All classroom assignments will be posted in Google Classroom by 8:00 am every day that a class meets.

What is different in Fall 2020 from the Spring 2020 semester?

Last semester (Spring 2020), attendance was encouraged but not mandatory. Teachers had office hours once a week and students could join and ask questions, only if they needed help. This semester attendance will be MANDATORY. Teachers will host classes every day on a bell schedule just like they would in person. They will be tracking attendance. Students must be in attendance at least 90% of the time to receive credit in a class. Because this is a short semester, 90% means they can only miss **three** days before losing credit.

Last semester, teachers only put in grades that helped students. In the 5th six weeks, this meant that they could not put in a zero if the student was missing assignments. In the 6th six week, teachers were grading all assignments, but the six weeks only counted if it raised the students semester average. This was only true for a very small portion of students. This semester, teachers will grade assignments they post regularly. They are checking for mastery of new information. GPA calculation will include new grades and rank will be recalculated with these new GPAs.

Finally, in the spring, teachers got to choose how they communicated with students. They would send out regular Zoom or Google Meet links. This year, every class will meet on Google Meet. What should I expect for my Mustang's day to look like?

Whereas most of our Mustangs will follow one of three bell schedules see bell schedule above. Below is a sample schedule that our Mustangs can adhere to based on a schedule without dual credit courses to maximize on their learning. We recommend your Mustang get up early to take care of their personal needs, shower, eat breakfast, and prepare for their first day.

During this Virtual learning time, teachers will be available to students and parents starting at 7am. The first class meeting of each day will start at 9am. Since Tuesday is a "B" day, students will see their 5th period teacher first. **Teachers are taking attendance.** Every class period will be 1 hour and 10 minutes. There is a 10 minute break between 1st and 2nd period and 3rd and 4th period to take care of personal needs. Lunch is 50 minutes long between the 2nd and 3rd period.

How do I know when my Mustang attends 1st-4th periods or 5th-8th periods?

1st-4th period classes meet on Mondays and Wednesdays. 5th-8th period classes meet on Tuesday and Thursdays. Fridays alternate between 1st-4th period and 5th-8th period. How does my Mustang join a Google Classroom?

Go to classroom.google.com.--->Make sure to sign in with your GP Apps account. If you're already signed in and need to switch accounts, in the top-right corner, click your profile picture and then select or add your account.--->At the top, click the "+", then **Join class**. Enter the class code from your teacher (check your gpapps email, your teacher may have emailed it to you) and click **Join**.





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How does my Mustang log into a Class?

Go to *classroom.google.com.--->* click on the class.---> Underneath the class title, click the Meet Link shown.---Click **Join Now**.

Use your username & universal password. Your Username is your (child's) 6-digit ID number and you (child's) password is gp followed by the student's sixdigit birthdate (gpmmddyy).
