





The War of 1812

The United States fought Britain in the War of 1812 to gain freedom of the seas and to end British interference with United States expansion westward. More and more people are moving to the west since the happening of the Louisiana Purchase.

- 1. The war itself didn't settle much. It wasn't a war over territories so no lands were won or lost, and no borders were changed.
- 2. The United States, a young nation, gained international respect for managing to withstand the British attack.
- **3.** The United States gained confidence and faith in the ability of its military.
- **4.**The war brought about long-term peace between the United States and Britain.
- **5.**The Capitol and the President's mansion and other buildings were burned, which led to a rebuilding of Washington, D.C.


