

2021-2022 Academic Eligibility Grading Calendar

Six-Weeks Grading Periods (High Schools)

First Grading Period

September	16	End of the First Six Weeks (7 day grace period)
September	23	Ineligible at the end of the school day
October	7	Grade check for ineligibles only (7 day grace period)
October	14	Becomes eligible if passing all subjects (at the end of the school day)

**** Also students become eligible if they did not qualify because of credits****Second Grading Period**

October	29	End of the Second Six Weeks (7 day grace period)
November	5	Ineligible at the end of the school day
November	19	Grade check for ineligibles only (7 day grace period)
December	3	Becomes eligible if passing all subjects (at the end of the school day)

Third Grading Period

December	17	End of the Third Six Weeks (7 day grace period)
January	11	Ineligible at the end of the school day
January	25	Grade check for ineligibles only (7 day grace period)
February	1	Becomes eligible if passing all subjects (at the end of the school day)

Fourth Grading Period

February	17	End of the Fourth Six Weeks (7 day grace period)
February	24	Ineligible at the end of the school day
March	11	Grade check for ineligibles only (7 day grace period)
March	25	Becomes eligible if passing all subjects (at the end of the school day)

Fifth Grading Period

April	8	End of the Fifth Six Weeks (7 day grace period)
April	15	Ineligible at the end of the school day
April	29	Grade check for ineligibles only (7 day grace period)
May	6	Becomes eligible if passing all subjects (at the end of the school day)

Sixth Grading Period

Students who passed all subjects on the **April 8th** check will be eligible through **May 27th**. Students who failed a subject at the end of the Fifth (5th) Six Weeks and did pass all subjects on the **April 29th** grade check will become eligible on **May 6th** (at the end of the school day) and remain eligible until the last day of school.

***All ineligible students become eligible at the end of the school day prior to “a school holiday period consisting of at least seven calendar days” (November 19th, December 17th, and March 11th). They revert to ineligible status when classes resume following the holiday period.**

Nine-Weeks Grading Periods (Middle & Elementary Schools)

First Grade "CHECK"

September	16	End of the First Six Weeks - Grade check Pass/Fail (7 day grace period)
September	23	Ineligible at the end of the school day
October	7	Grade check for ineligibles only (7 day grace period)
October	14	Becomes eligible if passing all subjects (at the end of the school day) ** Also students become eligible if they did not qualify because of credits

First Grading Period

October	7	End of the First Nine Weeks (7 day grace period)
October	14	Ineligible at the end of the school day
October	29	Grade check for ineligibles only (7 day grace period)
November	5	Becomes eligible if passing all subjects (at the end of the school day)

Second Grading Period

December	17	End of the Second Nine Weeks (7 day grace period)
January	11	Ineligible at the end of the school day
January	25	Grade check for ineligibles only (7 day grace period)
February	1	Becomes eligible if passing all subjects (at the end of the school day)

Third Grading Period

March	11	End of the Third Nine Weeks (7 day grace period)
March	25	Ineligible at the end of the school day
April	8	Grade check for ineligibles only (7 day grace period)
April	15	Becomes eligible if passing all subjects (At the end of the school day)

Fourth Grading Period

Students who passed all subjects on the **March 25th** check will be eligible through **May 27th**. Students who failed a subject at the end of the Third (3rd) Nine Weeks and did pass all subjects on the **April 8th** check will become eligible on **April 15th** (at the end of the school day) and remain eligible until the last day of school.

***All ineligible students become eligible at the end of the school day prior to "a school holiday period consisting of at least seven calendar days" (November 19th, December 17th, and March 11th). They revert to ineligible status when classes resume following the holiday period.**
