**2019-2020 U.I.L. Eligibility Grading Calendar**  
Six-Weeks Grading Periods

**First Grading Period**

September	27	End of the First Six Weeks (7 day grace period)
October	4	Ineligible at the end of the school day
October	18	Grade check <b>for ineligibles only</b> (7 day grace period)
October	25	Becomes eligible if passing all subjects (at the end of the school day) ** Also students become eligible if they did not qualify because of credits

**Second Grading Period**

November	1	End of the Second Six Weeks (7 day grace period)
November	8	Ineligible at the end of the school day
November	22	Grade check <b>for ineligibles only</b> (7 day grace period)
December	6	Becomes eligible if passing all subjects (at the end of the school day)

**Third Grading Period**

December	20	End of the Third Six Weeks (7 day grace period)
January	14	Ineligible at the end of the school day
January	27	Grade check <b>for ineligibles only</b> (7 day grace period)
February	3	Becomes eligible if passing all subjects (at the end of the school day)

**Fourth Grading Period**

February	21	End of the Fourth Six Weeks (7 day grace period)
February	28	Ineligible at the end of the school day
March	20	Grade check <b>for ineligibles only</b> (7 day grace period)
March	27	Becomes eligible if passing all subjects (at the end of the school day)

**Fifth Grading Period**

April	9	End of the Fifth Six Weeks (7 day grace period)
April	16	Ineligible at the end of the school day
April	30	Grade check <b>for ineligibles only</b> (7 day grace period)
May	7	Becomes eligible if passing all subjects (at the end of the school day)

**Sixth Grading Period**

Students who passed all subjects on the April 30<sup>th</sup> check will be eligible through May 28<sup>th</sup>. Students who failed a subject at the end of the Fifth (5<sup>th</sup>) Six Weeks and did pass all subjects on the April 30<sup>th</sup> grade check will become eligible on May 7<sup>th</sup> and remain eligible until the last day of school.

**\*All ineligible students become eligible at the end of the school day prior to “a school holiday period consisting of at least seven calendar days” (November 22, December 20, and March 6). They revert to ineligible status when classes resume following the holiday period.**

Nine-Weeks Grading Periods (All Middle Schools)

**First Grade “CHECK”**

September	27	End of the First Six Weeks - Grade check Pass/Fail (7 day grace period)
October	4	Ineligible at the end of the school day
October	18	Grade check <b>for ineligibles only</b> (7 day grace period)
October	25	Becomes eligible if passing all subjects (at the end of the school day) <b>** Also students become eligible if they did not qualify because of credits</b>

**First Grading Period**

October	18	End of the First Nine Weeks (7 day grace period)
October	25	Ineligible at the end of the school day
November	8	Grade check <b>for ineligibles only</b> (7 day grace period)
November	15	Becomes eligible if passing all subjects (at the end of the school day)

**Second Grading Period**

December	20	End of the Second Nine Weeks (7 day grace period)
January	14	Ineligible at the end of the school day
January	27	Grade check <b>for ineligibles only</b> (7 day grace period)
February	3	Becomes eligible if passing all subjects (at the end of the school day)

**Third Grading Period**

March	20	End of the Third Nine Weeks (7 day grace period)
March	27	Ineligible at the end of the school day
April	9	Grade check <b>for ineligibles only</b> (7 day grace period)
April	17	Becomes eligible if passing all subjects (At the end of the school day)

**Last Grading Period**

Students who passed all subjects on the April 9<sup>th</sup> check will be eligible through May 28<sup>th</sup>. Students who failed a subject at the end of the Third (3<sup>rd</sup>) Nine Weeks and did pass all subjects on the April 9<sup>th</sup> check will become eligible on April 17<sup>th</sup> and remain eligible until the last day of school.

**\*All ineligible students become eligible at the end of the school day prior to “a school holiday period consisting of at least seven calendar days” (November 22, December 20, and March 6). They revert to ineligible status when classes resume following the holiday period.**
