Full Membership:

Membership in the organization shall be open to parents/guardians of any current and active senior/graduation junior, who has been in compliance with all attendance and who has passed all exams necessary to graduate and has all credits needed to be eligible for graduation in the current school year. Each member will be allowed one (1) vote per issue taken up by the organization. Each household will be allowed two (2) voting members.

Officer positions need to be filled for:

President: Club leadership, mission development, administrative liaison, executive (rule enforcing) officer. Reaches out to community businesses for fundraising opportunities Typically acts as liaison between the club and the school administration

- Vice President: works closely with the president in fundraising ideas and reaching out to other groups.
- Takes over interim duties of the President if the President is unavailable

Secretary: Records meeting minutes, sends out regular communications, compiles member contact information
