

## *NSSH Formal Prom Dress Code*

Prom is a special night for NSSH students; therefore, we hope to maintain the integrity and formality of this special occasion by implementing a respectable and appropriate dress code. There are a multitude of beautiful, tasteful, and appropriate dresses, suits, and attire available for prom. Students will not be allowed into the dance if their attire does not meet the dress code. You are welcome to bring photos of your attire with poses from several different sides for pre-approval. As this is a school-sponsored activity, any person that attends this event must be in compliance with this dress code and all NSSH policies and procedures. Direct all questions to the high school administrative staff. The determination of the appropriateness of student dress and grooming shall rest with the principal, senior assistant principals, and senior class sponsors. Other teachers, office staff, and parents do not have authorization to approve prom attire.

### *Young Ladies:*

- Dresses must be formal, short or long, appropriately fitting and modest.
- **No** see through materials, extreme low backs, low necklines or visible midriffs (front or side).
- Dresses **must not** have a slit that extends above mid-thigh.
- Dresses may be backless as long as the back is not cut below the natural waistline (belly button).
- Dresses may be strapless (cut above the bust line) or include spaghetti straps.
- **No** more than a 1-inch gap between a top and a skirt for 2 piece dresses.
- **No** tennis shoes, flip-flops or slippers.
- **No** unnatural or extreme hair colors (ie: red, blue, purple, green).
- Cover-ups like sweaters and shawls **may not** be used to make a dress compliant with the dress code.



### *Young Men:*

- Tuxedos, Suits, or Sport coats with dress pants are suitable.
- Cut-off shirts, t-shirts or tank tops **may not** be worn under the suit jacket as the suit shirt.
- **No** tennis shoes, open toed shoes or slippers.
- **No** unnatural or extreme hair colors (ie: red, blue, purple, green).
- **No** bandannas, baseball caps, or non formal hats.
- **No** blue jeans/denim.



Any student or guest who is in violation of the dress code will not be allowed to enter the NSSH Prom and will be required to leave the premises.
