

## Class Work and Homework Policy

### For Students Attending Encounters

#### Class Work:

1. Students will be responsible for only an *understanding* of the content/concepts covered in regular class on their Encounters day, but they are **not** responsible for making up Encounters day class work.
2. Teachers should make every effort not to introduce new material or concepts or schedule special events on the day that students attend Encounters.
3. Major projects due on Encounters day must be turned in the next day or before their Encounters Day.

#### Assessments:

4. Encounters will be cancelled on district testing shut down days. The 2014-2015 District Assessments include **February 23<sup>rd</sup> & 24<sup>th</sup> and March 10<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup>**.
5. When other Assessments/Unit Tests (other than those listed above) are administered on Encounters Days, teachers will schedule an alternate test date to administer these exams to Encounters students.

#### Homework:

6. Encounters students are not responsible for completing homework assigned (by the home campus teacher) on the day they attend Encounters.

#### Grades:

7. Encounters students are expected to maintain good grades in class. Please contact the Encounters teacher if a student makes a D or F during any grading period.
