Galena Park ISD Administrator Receives Award from Marathon Oil

Houston, Texas: Congratulations to Mrs. Jacqueline Moreno, Director for Elementary Math and Science, for being selected to receive the Marathon Oil's Unconventional Thinking and Teaching award.

Through the Unconventional Thinking and Teaching grant program, Marathon Oil supports teachers who are bringing this same unconventional thinking to the classroom. Marathon Oil hopes to increase teacher retention by demonstrating support for the people who are responsible for developing our next generation of leaders, or unconventional thinkers.

In the program's first year, more than 140 entries were received and 14 educators were selected as winners across the nation.
