The Board of Trustees of Galena Park Independent School District met for a Special Meeting on Tuesday, June 18, 2019 with the following members present, to-wit: President, Wanda Heath Johnson; Vice President, Wilfred J. Broussard, Jr; Trustees: Jeff Miller, Minnie Rivera, Adrian Stephens and Dr. Angi Williams, Superintendent of Schools. Geneva Boyett recorded the minutes. Secretary, Ramon Garza was absent.
