

NOTIFICATION - LETTERMAN JACKET AWARD CRITERIA

Students enrolled in Galena Park ISD (GPISD) Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs are eligible to earn a letterman jacket when they meet certain criteria throughout their high school career. The rubric below identifies the criteria that must be met to earn a letterman jacket. It is the responsibility of the student to turn this paper into their campus CTE counselor for verification. Eligible students will be provided with a jacket packet and notified of the fitting date by their program instructor and / or Career and Technical Student Organization (CTSO) sponsor.

Letterman jackets are purchased through program activity funds. The jacket, front chest letter of the student's home campus, and program patch will be purchased using these funds. All other costs are at the expense of the student.

Student is enrolled in their second course within a Program of Study.		
Student has a 3.0 or higher GPA on a 4.0 scale in the courses within a Program of Study.	i	
Student completes at least one of the following:		
A. Student earned an Industry-Based Certification in their aligned POS.		
B. Student is a member of a Career and Technical Student Organization and competed at its local competition, Level 1 or Level 2.		
C. Student is an officer of a Career and Technical Student Organization.		

CTE reserves the right to revise any part of the rubric to include additional opportunities or clarify existing requirements. Based on the discretion of the CTSO sponsor, lettermen jackets can be purchased with CTSO activity funds or at the student's expense. This includes the jacket, front chest letter of the student's home campus, and program patch.
