



Association of Texas Professional Educators Galena Park Local 2023 Grant Information

The Galena Park ATPE acknowledges outstanding and creative ATPE members who develop programs or proposals intended to improve the quality of education for the children they serve. Grants are available for professional or associate members of the Galena Park Local Chapter and are exclusively for projects that directly effect students. The amount of the grant is \$500.00 maximum for the 2023-2024 school year.

Award Criteria:

- 1. Applicant must be an ATPE member within the GPISD local.
- 2. Applicants must use the 2023 Grant Application.
- 3. Applications must be typed or printed clearly using black ink.
- 4. Grant proposals must be solely for projects directly involving students.
- 5. Applicants should include an itemized cost analysis of all components of their proposals; an itemization of additional funds, if any, to be used for their proposed programs; and an explanation identifying the source of these funds. Individual grant request can not to exceed \$500.00
- 6. Grant recipients are required to show outcomes of the project in a presentation at a local ATPE meeting the following year.
- 7. Applicants cannot be winners of a 2020 or 2021 Grant and 2022 winners cannot have expenses covered by other grants/programs.
- 8. Completed applications must be <u>postmarked by February</u> <u>28, 2023</u>, or received via fax or inter-office mail by Wednesday, March 1, 2023.

Selection Process:

- 1. Applications must be **<u>postmarked</u>** no later than **February 28, 2023**. The committee will not consider late, incomplete, or illegible submissions.
- 2. The Grant Selection Committee members will review the applications.
- 3. The grant winners will be announced at our April meeting
- 4. The grant monies will be distributed upon submission of original receipts.

Essay Questions

Describe the project and/or identified need. How many students will be affected by your project? (Itemized expenses should not exceed \$500.00.)
 How do you plan to put the grant to use? If the grant will not cover planned expenditures, how will you generate additional funds?
 How does the learning experience in this proposal relate to the school curriculum?
