The Dr. Hunter Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is offered in memory of Dr. Tujuana Hunter. Dr. Hunter held a (Bachelor of Science in Business, Master of Theology and a Doctorate in Divinity). Dr. Hunter believed in service work--in her community, civic club, and in her political alliances. She had an affinity for setting up food drives, toy drives, and making someone else or a family feel just a little bit better.

Dr. Hunter was an active member of the East Houston Democrats. She was that quiet, resilient voice that kept attendance at all of our meetings. She also served as a Precinct Chair in her community.

Dr. Hunter was truly a part of what is right in the world. This scholarship is offered in memoriam of her spirit, quiet nature, and to represent that you don't have to make a lot of noise in this world to make a difference.

So, in honor of Dr. Hunter, this scholarship will be named-The Dr. Tujuana Hunter Memorial Scholarship-sponsored by the East Houston Democrats.

Criterion of the Scholarship:

**The student must be a graduating Senior of one of the High Schools located in Channelview, Galena Park or Sheldon Independent School Districts,
The student must maintain a C+ or above grade point average their senior year,
The student must be willing to donate political community service (15) hours to East Houston Democrats during the semester before graduation, and
The student will have to write an 600-word essay on (some political legislation) that they would like to see passed in the next five years.**

Four scholarships of \$500.00 will be given each school year to four seniors who qualify.

How the Scholarship Recipient will be selected:

***All paperwork must be submitted to East Houston Democratic Committee by April 21st of the Spring Semester.**

***Student must provide an updated transcript.**

***Student must provide a signed of copy of Parental agreement.**

***Committee to make final decision the end of May of the Spring Semester.**

Rubric for The Dr. Tujuana Hunter Memorial Scholarship

Each student applying has to write an original 600-word essay discussing a political concept that he/she would like to participate in getting passed in the near future.

Attached are the rubric and heading for the essay.

Outline of Paper

- Double Spaced
- 12 pt. Font
- Times New Roman
- Template provided for paper
- Two and two-thirds of a page only

Rubric for Paper

Content-40%

- Address the subject matter
- Content is sequential
- Content is structured

Grammar-30%

- Spelling-No spelling errors
- Punctuation-No punctuation errors
- Subject/Verb Agreement-No errors

Grammar-20%

- Spelling-Five words or less in error
- Punctuation-Five sentences or less in error
- Subject/Verb Agreement-Five sentences or less with incorrect tense

Grammar-10%

- Spelling-Five or more spelling errors
- Punctuation-Five sentences or more without correct punctuation
- Subject/Verb Agreement-Five sentences or more with incorrect tense

Paper Organization-30%

- Pagination (place number in the top right-hand corner)

Do not number the first page

- Double Space
- Indentation

Reference-Bonus Extra Points-10%
