Cougars	Expectations & Procedures
Students	<p>Students will travel from their classroom in lines to dances in an orderly fashion. All students will follow the instructions of teachers and principals when they arrive at dances. Students will be respectful to adults and other students. Students will eat in a designated area for snacks. Students will dance respectful at the dance and maintain 12 inches apart when they are dancing with other students. Students will follow the rules for playing board games and cards. When the students are finished playing games they will put them up and return them like they found them. Students will maintain their composure in a civilized manner. (Horse playing, running, hide-and- seek games are prohibited.) Students will exit the dances when dismissed and will walk back to class in quiet lines in an orderly fashion. Students with minor infractions (running, inappropriate dancing etc. will return to the classroom without a refund.</p>
Teachers	<p>Teachers will escort their students to all dances according to the schedule. Teachers will review dance etiquette and encourage students to keep moving and exercise patience while waiting for the dance. Teachers will be vocal, making rounds, and monitoring students at the dance. Teachers who have conference time will go to the cafeteria in advance and assist in the dance.</p>
Custodians	<p>Custodians will contact the main office if students are discovered in an unauthorized area.</p>
Secretaries	<p>Secretaries will monitor the office and assist visitors. Secretaries will communicate with principals if there is an emergency that needs immediate attention, otherwise they will handle all office business.</p>
Counselors	<p>Counselors will monitor the hallway while students are going to dances. When the hallway has completely emptied, counselors will attend the dances and assist in monitoring student behavior.</p>
Principal/APs	<p>Principals will assist and support teachers in escorting students to dances. They will be vocal and constantly moving around. They will remain proximal to students and address any inappropriate behavior.</p>
All Stakeholders	<p>In order to have effective dances all participants must understand the expectations. It is important that all are respected. Faculty and staff will address anyone who detracts from the integrity of dances.</p>



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
