03 Can I wear a dress with sequins and glitter?

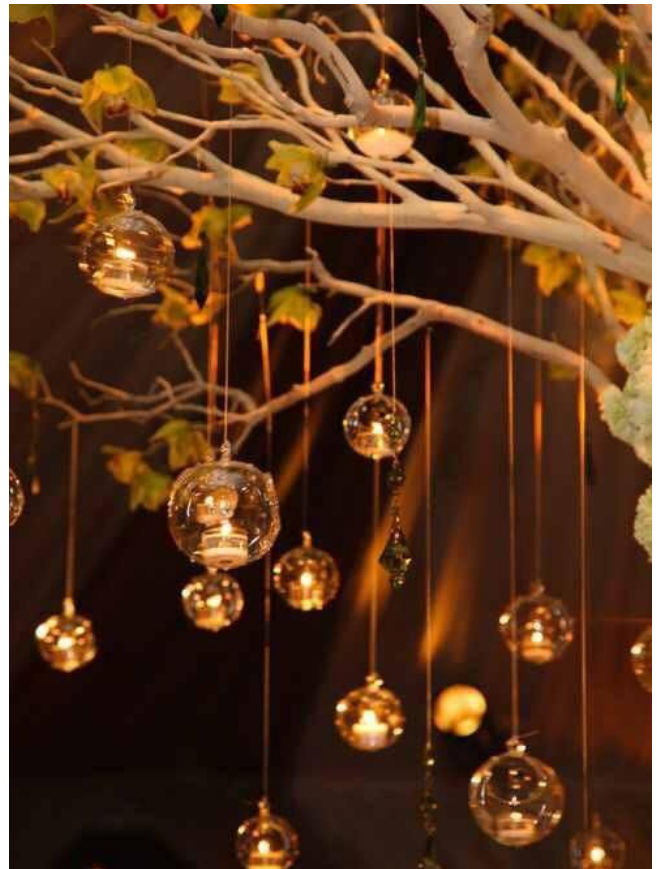
